

Dear Dr. Polsky:

I would like to thank you for your testimony. Your testimony was excellent in this case. It was honest and forthright. The plaintiff was awarded \$52,500.00. The problem is, the dog bite statute is a very rigorous standard to get over. I know you are familiar with the dog bite statute. It is a statute of strict liability. However, your testimony helped shed light on the fact that the plaintiff, his parents, and his sister each lied about how the incident occurred. The real version of the incident that the dog was going for the food appeared in the medical records, and you helped confirm the version of the incident which plaintiff's parents told the emergency room physician.
